Confess, read scripture, pray boldly, declare the possibility that God can bring a city-shaking revival to your community. Offer yourself as a vessel to be used of the Lord.

We forget that you chose only 12. Later, you sent out 70. And they turned village after village upside down. In three-and-a-half years, with your small band of less than 100, you shook an empire. Paul took Ephesus with a church of only a dozen re-baptized, Spirit-filled believers (Acts 19:6-7). The whole city was in an uproar. You had come to town. You shut down the pagan idol trade. You cleared the city of occult literature – without new laws, without a political appeal to the city-council, without a petition offered to the Mayor.

The stories abound – Gideon’s Army, David’s mighty men, Daniel and his three companions. You don’t need a multitude. You look for quality, more than quantity. You use the small things, the weak, to confound the mighty.

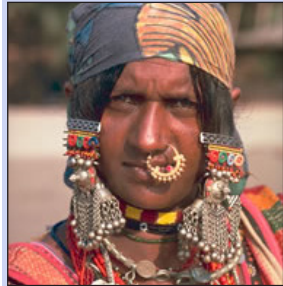

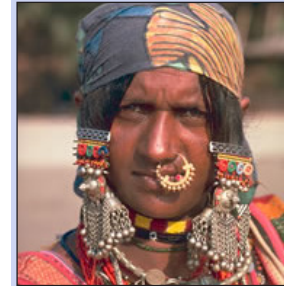
