Of the world's 15,958 Major People Groups, 6,415 (numbering 1.8 billion persons) are considered unreached. 1.3 billion are Muslims. 900 million are Hindus and 350 million Buddhists. 340 million people are involved in Chinese Folk Religions and 250 million people in various Tribal Religions. There are 875 million Atheists and Non-religious people. There are 17 million Jews.

Then suddenly, having won – they lost. Pagans flooded into the new popular churches endorsed by a Christian Emperor, the church failed to disciple its new converts. They failed to insist that the same strategy they had used to conquer paganism – every believer living in vital connection to God – was also necessary to sustain the movement. They let the lights go out. What followed were the dark ages.

We are letting it happen again. With a passive laity that is deeply dependent on clergy and a worship event that is performance driven, we are losing the culture. God have mercy on us. For your glory and the sake of your bride, infuse your church with a renewal of the Holy Spirit.
